

Medisyn Systems Internet Privacy Statement

I. Statement of Privacy for Customers and Website Visitors.

Medisyn Systems respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the privacy of our registered system users and website visitors.

Our Commitment to You Regarding Internet Privacy:

- WE ONLY COLLECT THE INFORMATION WE NEED TO PROVIDE THE SERVICE THAT YOU'VE REQUESTED.

- WE WILL NOT COLLECT PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION ABOUT YOU WHEN YOU VISIT OUR WEBSITES UNLESS YOU CHOOSE TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION TO US.

- WE WILL NOT SHARE ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION ABOUT YOU WITH ANY OTHER ORGANIZATIONS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.

We use the personal information that you provide upon registration only for the purpose of providing the “services” of Medisyn Systems. This information is used to uniquely identify you as a system user; to allow us to contact you as part of our independent source verification for new users; and to contact you for billing and payment related matters. Certain, limited, but otherwise publicly obtainable, information about you is available only to other registered Medisyn Systems users. We use your e-mail address to confirm your registration, to advise that your service has been activated, and to provide official service status notifications. In addition, we will occasionally send you updates about special offers, new product features and other noteworthy items about Medisyn Systems.

From time-to-time, Medisyn Systems may conduct online surveys. We value your opinions and comments and will solicit your input to help us improve our services, our website design and content, and our overall customer service. These surveys are entirely voluntary and any personal information requested is strictly optional.

The Medisyn Systems website contains links to other websites. When you click on one of these links, you are entering another website over which Medisyn has no control or responsibility. We encourage you to read the privacy statements of these sites, as they may differ from Medisyn's policies. Remember, you are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your passwords and any account information. Please exercise caution and be careful, responsible and alert with this information, especially whenever you are online.

When a registered Medisyn Systems user logs on to the system, Medisyn utilizes cookies to obtain information about the user's status within the system. Such information helps the system determine the identity of the user, the entity type of the user, and the level of

access authorized for the user. Cookies also enable Medisyn to determine the browser and operating system of the user's current session so that the appearance of the Medisyn pages is appropriate to the user's environment. The cookie is deleted by Medisyn Systems when the user leaves the Medisyn website. None of the cookie information is stored, maintained or utilized by Medisyn Systems other than for the purposes stated above.

Medisyn Systems does not collect any data about visitors (non-registered users) to the website.

We strive to ensure that any changes in the way Medisyn Systems uses the information we learn about you from our website will be reflected in the future versions of this Privacy Statement.

II. Statement of Privacy and Confidentiality for Patient Medical Records.

A good doctor-patient relationship is built on trust. Patients trust their healthcare provider to act on their behalf to promote their health and well-being. Healthcare providers maintain a medical record to allow the coordination of care among multiple providers for the patient, and to serve as the record of care delivered for reimbursement purposes. The medical record is a trusted document to be used by patient and healthcare providers together.

All Medisyn Systems patients must grant their healthcare providers permission to use their health information for the purpose of treatment, payment, and healthcare operations. Ethical medical practice requires that a patient's privacy rights, and preferences with respect to the confidentiality of their health information, be protected by all users of personally identifiable health information.

Medisyn Systems takes seriously the trust that its registered users have placed in it to protect both the confidentiality and security of all personal health information.

This means:

- Medisyn Systems protects the confidentiality and security of health information in accordance with the privacy practice agreed to by patient and the healthcare provider, subject to statutory requirements and regulations.
- Medisyn Systems permits system access only to other authorized Medisyn users for the exclusive purposes of:
 1. treatment
 2. payment of claims
 3. health care operations

- Medisyn Systems will grant system access only to entities directly involved in the delivery of healthcare. No employers, law enforcement, government, life insurance companies, or any other such organizations will be permitted access to the system by Medisyn.
- Medisyn Systems safeguards personal information about patients and healthcare providers from accidental or malicious disclosure by its employees and agents, or destruction from natural, inadvertent or malicious actions.
- Medisyn Systems discloses personally identifiable health information to other registered Medisyn users with the consent of the patient. Medisyn users are contractually bound by the same confidentiality agreements as Medisyn Systems, and may not use the information for any purpose other than treatment, payment, and health care operations.
- Medisyn Systems may provide aggregated health information (with all personally identifying information removed) without the authorization or consent of the patient, as provided by law.
- Medisyn Systems Web sites have features which assist healthcare providers in controlling access by their own employees to confidential computer-based personal health information.
- Medisyn Systems requires all of its own employees and contractors to abide by strict policies and procedures to protect the confidentiality and security of all health information.

III. Statement of Security Procedures

We consider the protection of all personally identifiable information we receive from our system users as critical to our corporate mission. Please be assured that we have security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse, and alteration of any information we receive from you. As in any transmission over the Internet, there is always some element risk involved. In order to try to minimize this risk, we utilize 128-bit encryption for all data passing both into and out of Medisyn Systems using the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.

A certificate is maintained through GoDaddy guaranteeing the encryption mechanism, which also protects users of the system by guaranteeing that the information received is coming from the real Medisyn Systems.

Medisyn Systems utilizes a firewall. The database is protected by the multi-level platform design of the system. Data from the Internet cannot pass through the web server to the database server.
